Last month we had a great **“You show me yours and I'll show you mine”** program. Many members brought their auto and home owners insurance policies and we compared types of coverage, amounts of insurance and rates. This was a very informative program and we learned some valuable lessons. 1) Coverage and rates varied widely. 2) Some companies seemed to have lower rates than others. 3) Everyone needs to co-ordinate their umbrella policy deductibles with their regular policies and should obtain a Workers' Compensation rider (cost less than \$10 per year). 4) You should have your broker explain your coverage and rates at least once every two years. 5) You can bring your policy to another broker and get a free quote to compare to what you now have and are paying.

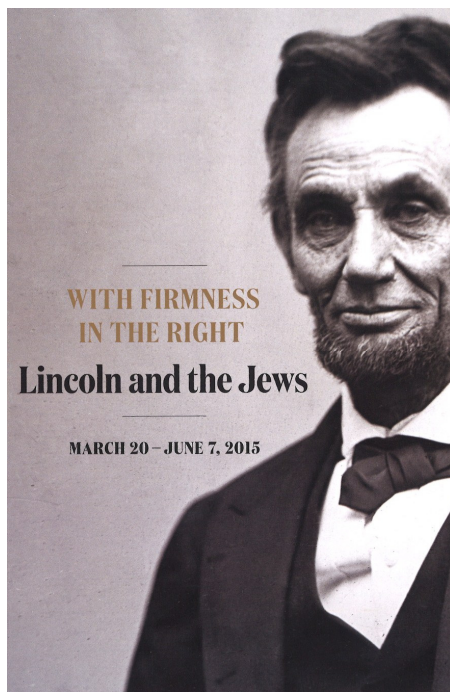

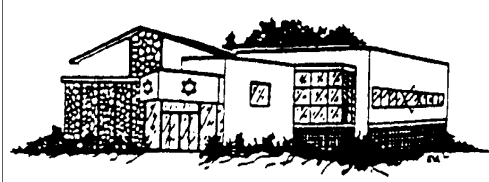
